Getting into Manchester

BY TRAIN

The station is located at the heart of the airport campus, which means passengers have easy access to all the terminals. With moving walkways throughout, it should take no more than 5 - 15 minutes to get to and

from the terminals. Trains from Manchester Airport to Manchester Piccadilly station in the city centre take around 20 minutes. They run every 10 minutes, 7 days a week, through train operators <u>TransPennine Express</u> and Northern Rail. Meanwhile, you can travel to just about anywhere in the UK from Manchester Piccadilly.

You can pre-book your train tickets <u>online</u>. You can also buy train tickets online for travel that day, or there are ticket machines and an information desk at the Manchester Airport train station.

BY BUS

Buses to Manchester Airport arrive at and leave from The Station, the airport's dedicated transport interchange. It's open 24 hours a day and links trains, coaches and buses into one building. It is connected to all terminals by the Skylink moving walkways, lifts and escalators.

The bus station at Manchester Airport is located in the airport train station. All three terminals are located within a 10-minute walk. You can find more information on bus routes to and from the airport on <u>TfGM's bus route planner</u>.

BY TAXI

A 100% wheelchair accessible fleet of Manchester licensed "black cab" taxis operates from Manchester Airport. Taxi ranks are located just

outside at all three Terminals and The Station. No booking is required, go straight to the taxi rank. Set fares for within the Manchester Licensed Area are shown on the taxi meter <u>HERE</u>.








Useful Apps
